ARTS 14C occupies the entire 4th, 5th and 6th floors of the landmark 150 Bay building in the Powerhouse Arts District of downtown Jersey City.



Project 14C, a series of artist residencies, is part of ARTS 14C's multidisciplinary arts incubator and creative community.

Our subsidized live/work loft spaces are available for three types of residency:

- 12-month fellowship live/work residency
- 3-month fellowship live/work residency (for international artists without long-term visas or those with unique circumstances)
- Short term Special Project residencies

Full and partial residencies begin on March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1.

Special Project residencies have varying dates.





Across the Hudson River from Lower Manhattan and New York City, Jersey City is one of America's most culturally diverse and vibrant cities, with more than 40 languages spoken.

Project 14C is in the Jersey City's Powerhouse Arts District, 10 minutes from Manhattan by PATH train.



The ARTS 14C vision

A program of ARTS 14C, the Project 14C residency is an innovative co-living community designed for fine artists, filmmakers, writers, designers, performers - all the creative arts.

We believe that creativity flourishes in a vibrant, supportive and affordable community. Our mission is to provide a nurturing environment where diverse talents can come together to live, work, and inspire one another, while building the foundation for a lasting career in the arts with professional development & mentorship.

ARTS 14C offers modern, comfortable and subsidized studio living spaces and art facilities for our residents.



The ARTS 14C difference

More than 80% of arts residency programs are rural, offering artists the chance to focus on their work in a natural - often spectacular - setting, a respite from daily life.

ARTS 14C is inescapably urban and community focused.

We expect residents to interact with one another, collaborate across disciplines and explore all of the creative opportunities in Jersey City and the New York City area. Our only requirement of our artists is 36 hours of volunteer service over the course of the year.

Although ARTS 14C's facilities are self contained, we regularly invite other members of the arts community - and the wider community - into our space.

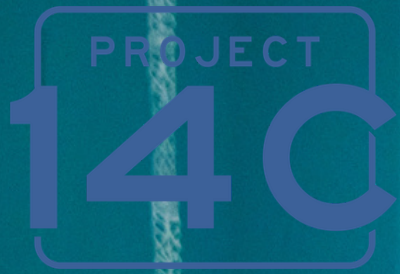

12- & 3-month residency costs and restrictions

- Artists or groups of artists of all creative disciplines will be considered for Project 14C, including visual arts, performing arts, literary arts, music, film, fashion, architecture and design etc.
- Artists must be at least 21 years of age at the start of the program.
- Because it is housed in an historic building, the program is not suited for artists who require open flame or toxic materials with fumes or dust in their practice.
- Studios range from 840 sq ft to 1504 sq ft. Most work well for one or two artists, maximum of four artists. **Artists who wish to share a studio must apply with studio mates. 14C will not match and place artists.**
- Program fees start at \$2,046/month for a single, with an average of \$1200 for artists who share.
- **Fees are all inclusive** - no extra charges for utilities or programs.
- Fellowship artists are accepted quarterly, with residencies beginning on March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1.

To apply

What you will need:

- Documentation of your arts practice - clear images, videos, pdfs etc.
- A minimum of two references - one from someone who knows you personally, and the other from someone who knows you professionally.
- Articulation of why you are suited to this residency, what you hope to gain from it, and how you will contribute to the 14C community.
- If you are planning to share a live/work studio space, the names of the other artists.
- You do not have to complete the application in one sitting - it can be saved and edited.

Special Project Residency



The Special Project is a fast-paced, purpose-driven residency within the larger Project 14C program.

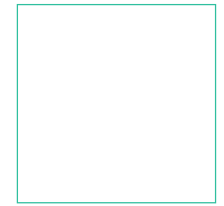
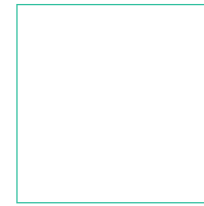
While our 12-month full residencies and 3-month partial residencies focus on long-term career development and mentorship, the Special Project is all about bringing an ambitious creative idea to life - from start to finish.

Residents receive generous studio space and as much as 11 weeks (each Special Project has a different timeline) to immerse themselves fully in their work. Studios are offered **free of charge**, with only small fees for cleaning and utilities. With three sessions each year, cohort sizes shift depending on available space; in 2025, groups ranged from 7 to 25 artists.
