ARTS 14C occupies three full floors of the landmark 150 Bay building in the Powerhouse Arts District of downtown Jersey City.



Project 14C, a series of artist residencies, is part of ARTS 14C's multidisciplinary arts incubator and creative community.

Our subsidized live/work loft spaces are available through four residency programs:

- 12-month Artist Fellowship live/work residency
- 3-month Artist Fellowship live/work residency (for international artists without long-term visas or those with unique circumstances)
- 12-month Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellowship (**NEW for 2026/27**)
- Short-term Special Project residencies

Artist fellowship residencies begin on March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1. Curatorial Fellowship begins December 1.

Special Project residencies have varying start dates and residency lengths.





Across the Hudson River from Lower Manhattan and New York City, Jersey City is one of America's most culturally diverse and vibrant cities, with more than 40 languages spoken.

Project 14C is in Jersey City's Powerhouse Arts District, 10 minutes from Manhattan by PATH train.

The ARTS 14C vision

Project 14C is ARTS 14C's multidisciplinary residency program and creative community, bringing together visual artists, filmmakers, writers, designers, performers, musicians, curators and other arts professionals.

We believe creativity flourishes in a vibrant, supportive and affordable community. Project 14C gives residents the space, resources, professional development and mentorship to build sustainable careers -- while living and working alongside people from across the creative disciplines.

ARTS 14C provides modern, comfortable, subsidized live/work spaces along with shared studios, production facilities and opportunities to connect with audiences.



The ARTS 14C difference

Unlike residencies built around retreat and isolation, ARTS 14C is inescapably urban and community focused.

We expect residents to engage with one another, collaborate across disciplines and take advantage of the extraordinary creative communities of Jersey City and New York City.

Artist Fellowship residents contribute 36 hours of volunteer service over the course of a 12-month residency. The Curatorial Fellow's service commitment is fulfilled through their work with Gallery 14C.

And while ARTS 14C's facilities are extensive, we are not a closed community. We regularly welcome artists, arts organizations, audiences and members of the wider community into our space.

Recording Studio 14C

Recording Studio 14C is operated in partnership with producer Chris Sieg, who owns, maintains, and oversees the studio's professional equipment. At its heart is legendary recording gear from acclaimed producer and engineer Bob Power.

Chris has collaborated with dozens of Project 14C residents on projects ranging from sound bites to full-length albums, bringing technical expertise and creative insight to each collaboration.

Residents receive nearly unlimited free studio time each month, with equipment access available to those trained in its use. Chris also works with residents on longer-term projects when there is a strong creative fit.



Dance Studio 14C



The 14C Textile Lab is the result of our partnership with Project Runway, as well as donations from various film and TV wardrobe departments. Overseen by designer Tyler Neasloney, the Lab is open to all textile, fashion and fiber artists in the 14C program.

Gallery 14C is ARTS 14C's exhibition space, presenting four curated exhibitions each year featuring Project 14C residents as well as artists and organizations from the wider arts community. Gallery 14C is a 4,000 sq ft exhibition space with 12-foot ceilings, concrete floors and an industrial character. An additional 1,000 sq ft back-of-house area includes storage and a kitchen.

For the December 2026 cohort, we're introducing a new opportunity: the Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellowship.

Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellowship

A 12-month live/work residency. A gallery to make your own.

The Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellow receives a full 12-month Project 14C residency at no cost while serving as Gallery 14C's Curator-in-Residence for the fellowship year, with mentorship and support from ARTS 14C.

The fellow will shape and oversee Gallery 14C's four-show annual exhibition program, working within two established 14C exhibitions and having broad creative freedom over the remainder of the year.

WINTER | Project 14C Group Exhibition January–April 2027

A curated group exhibition featuring current Project 14C residents.

SPRING | Salon des Refusés April–June 2027

An exhibition drawn from applicants to the Showcase at the 7th Edition of Art Fair 14C.

SUMMER | Curate or Collaborate July–September 2027

Develop an original exhibition or invite another arts nonprofit to take over Gallery 14C.

FALL | Curator's Exhibition October 2027–January 2028

An exhibition entirely conceived and curated by the fellow. ARTS 14C assumes operational responsibility after November 30.

Applicants must have demonstrated curatorial and/or gallery administration experience and should be comfortable with both the creative and practical responsibilities of producing exhibitions and working with artists.

Fellowship term: December 1, 2026–November 30, 2027

12- & 3-month Artist Fellowship residencies: costs & restrictions

- Artists or groups of artists of all creative disciplines will be considered, including visual arts, performing arts, literary arts, music, film, fashion, architecture, design etc.
- Artists must be at least 21 years of age at the start of the program.
- Because it is housed in an historic building, the program is not suited for artists who require open flame or toxic materials with fumes or dust in their practice.
- Studios range from 840 sq ft to 1,504 sq ft. Most work well for one or two artists, maximum of four artists. **Artists who wish to share a studio must apply with studio mates. 14C will not match and place artists.**
- Program fees start at \$2,030/month for a single, with an average of \$1200 for artists who share.
- **Fees are all inclusive** - no extra charges for utilities or programs.
- Fellowship artists are accepted quarterly, with residencies beginning on March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1.

Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellowship

- The Curatorial Fellow receives a 12-month live/work residency at no cost in recognition of their year-long responsibility for Gallery 14C's exhibition program.
- The fellowship is open to applicants with curatorial and/or gallery administration experience.
- Curatorial Fellowship is awarded once a year as part of the December 1 cohort.

How to Apply: Artist Fellowship Residencies

What you will need:

- Documentation of your arts practice - clear images, videos, PDFs etc.
- A minimum of two references - one from someone who knows you personally and the other from someone who knows you professionally.
- Articulation of why you are suited to this residency, what you hope to gain from it, and how you will contribute to the 14C community.
- If you plan to share a live/work studio, the names of the other applicants. Each person sharing the space must submit a separate application.
- The application can be edited and amended, even once submitted, up until the deadline.

How to apply for Gallery 14C Curatorial Fellowship

We're selecting a curator, not an exhibition proposal.

What you will need:

- CV/resumé demonstrating curatorial and/or gallery administration experience
- Documentation of exhibitions or arts programs you have curated, organized, or administered
- A brief statement describing your curatorial interests and approach
- A preliminary idea or areas of interest for your Fall 2027 exhibition. This does not need to be a fully developed proposal - we want to understand your ideas and interests, not see the entire year of exhibitions predetermined
- A brief statement explaining why Project 14C interests you and how you see yourself contributing to the residency community
- At least one professional reference who can speak to your ability to work with artists and produce exhibitions

Special Project Residency

The Special Project is a fast-paced, purpose-driven residency within the larger 14C program.

While our 12-month and 3-month fellowship residencies focus on long-term career development and mentorship, the Special Project is all about bringing an ambitious creative idea to life – from start to finish.

Residents receive generous studio space and up to 11 weeks to immerse themselves fully in their work. Each Special Project has its own timeline. Studios are offered **free of charge**, with only modest fees for cleaning and utilities. With three sessions each year, cohort sizes shift depending on available space; in 2025, groups ranged from 7 to 25 artists.

The next multi-disciplinary Special Project Residency is November 20, 2026 - February 7, 2027.

Every ARTS 14C program advances our mission to increase opportunities for artists, strengthen creative careers and expand public access to the arts.



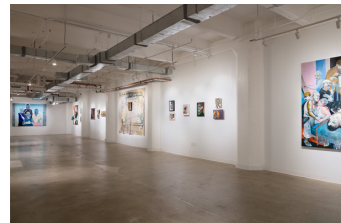
Access 14C: Makes the arts more welcoming and accessible through programs including low-sensory tours and experiences for people with disabilities.
